- Application Process:
 - Online application through the respective university or institution's website
 - Submission of required documents (academic transcripts, ID proof, etc.)

Specific

- Candidate must be present at the time of admission.
- Carry all the documents in original including the ATKT, mark lists if any.
- Read the checklist on page 4 & 5 very carefully and arrange the documents in that order.
- Do not approach the institution without the original documents.
- Carry all the scans of the documents in a pen drive. Scans should be very clear.
 - Size of the documents:
 - All the Degree certificates/ mark list together should <u>not exceed</u> <u>1000KB</u>
 - All the PG /mark lists should <u>not exceed 500KB</u>
 - All the other single documents (Domicile/birth/caste certificate etc.) should <u>not exceed 200KB</u>
- Office hours for admission: 11.00am to 4.00pm
- For any other questions, please visit the institution.

Instructions for reserve category candidates:

- If you have availed the scholarship at post-graduation, then you may not get the scholarship for B.Ed.
- If you have been allotted a seat other than your category, you are required to pay the full fees as per the government resolution from time to time.
