# **B.Ed Admission Eligibility and Process** –

# **Late Khatija College of Education (B.ED)**

(Affiliated to the University of Mumbai)

To be considered for admission to the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) program at Late Khatija College of Education, affiliated with the University of Mumbai, prospective candidates must meet the following eligibility criteria and adhere to the outlined admission process:

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

#### 1. Educational Qualification:

- o Possession of a Bachelor's degree in Arts, Science, Commerce, or an equivalent qualification from a recognized university.
- o Alternatively, a Master's degree from a recognized university is also acceptable.
- o Candidates holding a B.E./B.Tech degree are eligible to apply.
- 2. Minimum Marks in Qualifying Examination:
- o General Category: A minimum aggregate score of 50% in the Bachelor's or Master's degree.
- Reserved Categories (SC/ST/OBC/VJ-NT/SBC of Maharashtra): A minimum aggregate score of 45% in the Bachelor's or Master's degree.
- o **B.E./B.Tech Candidates:** A minimum aggregate score of 55% in their respective degree.
- 3. Entrance Examination:
- o A valid and qualifying score in the **Maharashtra B.Ed Common Entrance Test (MAH B.Ed CET)** conducted by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra, is mandatory.
- 4. Additional Requirements:
- Candidates who have obtained their qualifying degree from a university other than the University of Mumbai are required to procure an **Eligibility Certificate** from the University of Mumbai prior to admission.
- o Applicants whose degree utilizes a CGPI or grading system must submit a **conversion certificate** from the issuing institution, clearly indicating the equivalent percentage of marks.
- o Participation in the **centralized counseling process** conducted by the relevant authorities post the MAH B.Ed CET is a prerequisite for seat allocation at Late Khatija College of Education.
- 5. Age Limit:
- o There is no stipulated upper age limit for admission to the B.Ed program. However, candidates are generally expected to be at least 19 years of age at the time of admission.

### **Application Process:**

The admission process involves the following key stages:

- 1. **MAH B.Ed CET Registration:** Interested candidates must register for the MAH B.Ed CET through the official portal of the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra.
- 2. **Online Application Submission:** Following successful registration for the CET, candidates need to complete the online application form for the B.Ed program. This includes providing necessary personal and academic details, uploading scanned copies of required documents (mark sheets, degree certificates, identity proof, category certificate if applicable, etc.), and paying the prescribed application fee through the designated online payment gateway.

- 3. **Appear for MAH B.Ed CET:** Candidates must appear for the MAH B.Ed CET on the scheduled date and secure a valid score as per the eligibility criteria.
- 4. **Centralized Counselling Participation:** Based on the merit list prepared using the MAH B.Ed CET scores, eligible candidates will be required to participate in the centralized counseling process. During this process, candidates can indicate their preferences for colleges, including Late Khatija College of Education, and seats will be allotted based on merit and availability.
